- Provide resources, facilities, finances, information, instruction, training and supervision as necessary, to maintain a positive environmental culture and performance
- Set to monitor key objectives and targets for managing FC environmental performance on regular basis and encourage feedback
- Review FC environmental policy regularly at least annually
